St. Peter School offers a healthy Type A lunch meal to all students, every school day. As a reminder, due to Senate Bill 310, the price we charge for our school lunches needs to be increased. The increase for our school lunch price for the school year 2020-2021 is listed below.

Lunch Prices for the **2020-2021** school year are as follows:
\$2.85 Daily \$14.25 for a 1 Week Ticket \$28.50 for a 2 Week Ticket

Reduced-Priced Meals
.40 Daily \$2.00 for a 1 Week Ticket \$4.00 for a 2 Week Ticket

.50 Each for Milk

\$2.50 for a 1 Week Milk Ticket

*Milk is included with each meal

Ala Carte Ice Cream - POSTPONED until a later date

Due to COVID-19, we will be delaying all ice cream items until a later time, to help eliminate transitions and potential exposures.

*However, we will still offer ice cream to be bought for the whole class for special occasions, such as birthdays.

For ordering purposes, please let us know at least a week in advance.

Menu:

Lunch menus for St. Peter School are sent home at the beginning of the month with the oldest child. If you happen to misplace the menu, please call the school or send a note and we will be glad to send another one home. Our menu is the same as Upper Sandusky Exempted Village Schools that is posted in the Daily Chief Union Newspaper.

FREE & REDUCED PRICED MEALS

Applications for the Federal Lunch Program will be sent out on the first day of school. Families may apply for this program by filling out the necessary form. If you feel you qualify, please fill out the form and return it to the school as soon as possible. If you participated in the free and reduced lunch program last school year, your child/children will continue to be on the program for the first 30 days. Concerning Charges:

As a parent it is your responsibility to provide your child with lunch money or a packed lunch. We understand that sometimes things get hectic in the mornings. We will allow the student to charge 3 times before a reminder note will be sent home.

Sending Money to School

When sending money to school, **please send the money in an envelope** and put the child/children's name and grade on it. We ask that you send checks if at all possible, as this keeps money from being lost. If you are paying for more than one child, you may send check/money in one envelope, just print each child's name and grade on the envelope.

Please send lunch money in a different envelope, separate from Book fees/Tuition and Extended Day.
