Just Thought You Should Know...

- This is a general reminder that there can be NO PARKING in the designated bus unloading zone from 7:00-8:00 AM and again from 2:30-3:00 PM. Buses will be unloading students during these times and they need these areas cleared. Also, when dropping students off in the morning using the "U" drive through in the parking lot beside the school, please refrain from allowing students to exit the vehicle until you have reached the sidewalk outside the gym doors. There is a lot of morning traffic and we don't want our students having to cross in front of vehicles. If you have any questions about this process, please let us know.
- We will begin our Fall MAP testing this week with our upper classes. MAP testing is our school's version of state standardized testing and is a certified alternate assessment for those tests. Grades 3-6 take Reading, Math, Language Arts, and Science while grades K-2 take Reading and Math. The scores from these tests will help us determine where our students are academically as well as what content areas we need to focus on as a staff. If you have any questions about MAP testing, please feel free to contact us.
- Reminder, there will be no school on Monday, September 5th in observance of Labor Day as well as Thursday and Friday, September 15th and 16th due to the Wyandot County Fair. This is a change from the earlier schedule so please make a note.
